


- In 2015, 26% of the world's population was under 15 years of age
- By 2050, there will be nearly 10 billion people of which **2.6 billion will be under 18**

In 2014, approximately 15 million people were trained in first aid by National Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies in 116 countries around the globe by more than 180,000 active first aid trainers
